CURRICULAR PROFILE

María Teresa Jiménez Esquivel comes from a working-class family; from a young age, she has dedicated herself to fighting for people and serving others with dedication and passion.

She holds a Bachelor's degree in Political Science and Public Administration, pursued two master's degrees, one in Public Policy and another in Public Management; in addition to obtaining a PhD in Law. Her academic background has allowed her to specialize in Municipal Planning, Public Policy, Electoral Law, and Gender Equality.

She has held various public positions at the federal, state, and municipal levels; her professional performance has always been related to municipal strengthening and federalism, which are the basis of social and political organization in Mexico.

In 2017, she was elected as Mayor of Aguascalientes, where she was characterized by leading a near to the people and transparent government with responsible management of public resources, which led her to be re-elected to the position in 2019.

In her second term as head of the Municipal Government, she promoted the modernization of 100% of public lighting, the creation of a Municipal Assistance Center to facilitate the completion of more than 100 municipal procedures in one place, and the application of new technologies to reinforce public security and reduce response times in emergency cases, among many other achievements.

Tere Jiménez is not only the youngest woman to have held the Mayor's Office of Aguascalientes but also the first woman to be re-elected to such a position.

Currently, she serves as the Constitutional Governor of the State of Aguascalientes for the period 2022-2027, being the first woman to hold this position in that federative entity.

She has committed to leading an efficient government that provides solutions and results, highlighting three important pillars to promote state development: one, for peace and values in favor of state security; two, for prosperity, rights, and opportunities for all, and three, sustainable growth, innovation for work, to continue promoting Aguascalientes not only nationally but internationally.

She was recently unanimously appointed as president of the Association of National Action Governors (GOAN), from where she has called for unity and national coordination to overcome Mexico's challenges and for each of the leading entities to consolidate as a national and international example of progress and prosperity.
